Costume Loans/Rentals Agreement

The agreement for borrowed costumes is simple:

- 1. A token cash/check donation for loft upkeep and purchase of costume-worthy pieces.
- 2. Volunteer help of at least two hours for large loans and one hour for small loans. Many borrowers bring groups and graciously offer several hours of volunteer help. Keeping order in the loft is a job of considerable magnitude; therefore, volunteer help is essential. Many schools borrow van loads of costumes and bring some of the cast to pay back.
- 3. Proper cleaning of costumes is also required before returns are made. Kay Yaukey determines the meaning of "proper!"
